NOW, on this 1st day of October, 2021, this matter comes on before the above-named Court on the State's Motion for Authorization for Prosecution as an Adult, the Honorable Merlin G. Wheeler, presiding. The State of Kansas appears by and through Amy L. Aranda, First Assistant Lyon County Attorney, and Laura L. Miser, Assistant Lyon County Attorney. The juvenile appears in person and with counsel, James Heathman. Also present are the natural mother and natural father.

THEREUPON, the Court takes up the juvenile's Motion to Continue, and hears statements and arguments of counsel.

THEREUPON, the Court initially denies the motion in part, and orders the State to proceed with the presentation of its witnesses; however, the Court will consider continuing the cross examination of said witnesses until after the juvenile's expert witness has completed his evaluation of the juvenile and submitted a written opinion.

THEREUPON, the parties present the written evidentiary stipulation to facts regarding the identity of the deceased victim herein.

THEREUPON, the Court inquires of the juvenile and determines that the juvenile's stipulation is knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently made after sufficient consultation with counsel, and accepts the same.

THEREUPON, the Court announces to the parties that due to technical problems with the electronic equipment in the courtroom, the Court must continue the hearing to a different date.

WHEREUPON, the Court continues the hearing on the State's Motion for Authorization for Prosecution as an Adult to January 24, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. through January 26, 2022.
