NOW, on this 8th day of November, 2021, this matter comes on before the above-named Court for preliminary hearing, the Honorable Jeffry J Larson, District Judge, presiding. The State of Kansas appears by and through Amy L Aranda, First Assistant County Attorney, and Laura L. Miser, Assistant County attorney. Defendant appears in person and by and through counsel, Chris Biggs.

THEREUPON, the Plaintiff presents evidence, and the court recesses for the day.

THEREUPON, the court reconvenes on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021, the Plaintiff presents evidence, and the court recesses for the day.

THEREUPON, the court reconvenes on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021, the Plaintiff presents evidence and rests.

THEREUPON, the Defendant presents no evidence and rests.

THEREUPON, the Plaintiff moves to amend the Complaint/Information to dismiss Count 5 of the Complaint/Information charging arson.

THEREUPON, the Court inquires and hearing no objection from the defendant, grants the State's motion and dismisses Count 5 of the Complaint/Information without prejudice.

THEREUPON, the Court after hearing testimony and being otherwise duly and fully advised in the premises, finds probable cause to believe the Defendant committed a felony in Lyon County, Kansas, as follows:

**Count 4 - Aggravated robbery; Inflicts bodily harm**

That on or about the 5th day of September, 2017, in Lyon County, Kansas, Armando Nunez, then and there being present did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly take property, to-wit: US Currency, AK47 rifle, speaker, and/or Nissan Altima vehicle, from the person or presence of Jesus Avila Jr, by force, or by threat of bodily harm to any person, and during the course of such robbery, bodily harm was inflicted upon Jesus Avila Jr. In violation of K.S.A. 21-5420(b), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Kansas. (Severity Level 3 Person Felony) [21.5420.b.2]

**Count 6 - Interference with LEO; Conceal/alter/destroy evidence**

That on, about, or between the 5th day of September, 2017 and the 3rd day of March, 2018, in Lyon County, Kansas, Armando Nunez, then and there being present did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly conceal, destroy or materially alter evidence with the intent to prevent or hinder the apprehension or prosecution of any person, and further said act was committed in the case of a felony. In violation of K.S.A. 21-5904(a)(2) & (b)(4)(B), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Kansas. (Severity Level 8 Non-person Felony) [21.5904.a2.b4.B]

THEREUPON, the Court binds the Defendant over for arraignment and pretrial conference on December 3, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. All pretrial motions are to be filed with the Court prior to the pretrial conference.

THEREUPON, the Court takes up the defendant's motion to modify bond.

THEREUPON, the Court hears statements and arguments of counsel and modifies the bond to \$250,000 cash/surety with the same special conditions as previously imposed.
